Sub : Grant of Academic Autonomy Status

Ref : UGC letter No. F.22-1/2017 (AC), dated 08.06.2017

Sir,

I am directed to inform you that in pursuance to decision of the 30th Board of Management meeting held on 24.07.2017, the academic autonomy is granted in favour of Gandhi Institute of Engineering & Technology (GIET), Gunupur as per Sub section (iii) of Section 5 of the BPUT Act, 2002. The details regarding the autonomy and the accompanying conditions that applies are :

1. The Autonomy would be operative from the new academic session, starting from academic session 2017-18 to 2022-23.
2. The autonomy is granted to GIET, Gunupur as approved by UGC, New Delhi.
3. The college shall admit students in respect of the courses for which Academic Autonomy is conferred against the syllabus, course-content etc. as submitted by the college. The method of conducting examination, evaluation, award of grades would be primarily guided by the provisions of the Regulations of the University.
4. The college shall have the power to make its own rules, regulations or by-laws in consonance with the guideline prescribed by the UGC/ BPUT and the laws framed thereunder for the purpose of fulfilling the objectives for conferring the status of autonomy.
5. The college shall have a Governing Body, Academic Council and appropriate Board of Studies and other committees as per requirement of UGC with adequate number of University representatives to ensure the quality and standards of courses for the subjects and shall be comparable to the quality standards prescribed by the University/ UGC.
6. Admission of students to the UG & PG programmes offered by the college shall conform to the provisions of 'The Orissa Professional Educational Institution (Regulation of Admission and Fixation of Fee) Act, 2007'.


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7. The University shall have the power to confer the degree on students who have satisfactorily completed the approved courses of studies at GIET, Gunupur.
8. The Board of Management of the University shall have the power to revoke the autonomy at any time after scrutiny and after giving due notice of such intention to the college before the expiry of such period granted from time to time, in case of deteriorating standards or for any other good cause.
9. The Board of Management of the University shall have the power to monitor the functioning of the college through periodic review; it will have the power for inspection or cause inspection to be made by such person or persons to the college and its buildings, workshops etc. and would also have the right to scrutinize the process of teaching, examination and other work conducted or done by the college. The Board would also have the power to make such inquiry and issue notice to the Principal on the academic matter of the college.
10. Notwithstanding this, conferment of autonomous status to GIET, Gunupur, the latter would be subject to such orders, rules, regulations, guidelines and directions as may be issued from time to time, by the Central Government or UGC or AICTE under the provision of UGC Act -1956, AICTE Act -1987 and Act of the University.
11. The college has indemnified the University through an affidavit against the possible risk of financial, and other liabilities/ involvements/ responsibility associated with the GIET, Gunupur shall applicable mutatis and mutandis.

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
